Start your child in a rear-facing car seat in the back seat. Rear-face until at least age 2 and until they reach the upper weight and height limits of the seat (even up to age 4). If your child outgrows their car seat before age 2, change to a seat with higher rear-facing weight and height limits. Keep rear-facing as long as possible.

A 5-point harness provides more protection than a seat belt used with a booster seat or a seat belt alone. Make sure that the harness fits snugly around your child's hips and shoulders. We will show you how to do the Pinch Test in Tip #4. Booster Seat: After your child has outgrown the car seat harness, move to a booster seat. Use the car's lap and shoulder seat belt with a booster seat as shown in the video above.

Children should ride in a vehicle's back seat in rear-facing safety seats from birth until at least age 2, or until they reach their convertible seat's upper weight limit, which should be around 35 pounds. Be sure both age and weight requirements are met before a child is moved to a forward-facing seat.

Seat belts fit properly when the lap belt lays across the upper thighs (not the stomach) and the shoulder belt lays across the chest (not the neck). Proper seat belt fit usually occurs when children are about 4 feet 9 inches tall and ages 9-12 years. Seat belt fit can vary by vehicle so check fit in all vehicles.

Children under seven years must use a child car seat that's the right size, correctly installed and adjusted to fit. Keep children in child car seats until they've outgrown the size limit, regardless of age. Children aren't ready to use adult seatbelts until they can pass the five-step test or are 145 cm tall.

Pass the seatbelt over your child's lap and chest placing both the lap and diagonal portions of the seatbelt over the child seat's red guide on the buckle side of the seat. Click the seatbelt into the buckle and check that it's correctly positioned across your child and that the seatbelt is flat and smooth.
