The learner uses generalized patterns, principles, and other similarities between past experiences and novel experiences to more efficiently navigate the world. For example, if a person has learned in the past that every time they eat an apple, their throat becomes itchy and swollen, they might assume they are allergic to all

Substantial research indicates that generalization of learning does not occur automatically and that special techniques are frequently required to promote skill generalization. Particular problems with generalization have been observed among readiness, preacademic, prerequisite, and generic skill training tasks that are common to early childhood curricula.

According to Marton and colleagues (2004, pp. 16-17), there are four patterns of variation: contrast (i.e., recognizing values of an aspect), generalization (i.e., experiencing varied appearances of the same value), separation (i.e., separating aspects with varying values from invariant aspects), and fusion (i.e., experiencing several critical aspects simultaneously).

If such variation in resource use is associated with personality, it could affect the evolution of life histories (Wolf and Weissing 2012).
